

Abuse of Officials

The IEOC is sadly being made aware of an increasing number of incidents of abuse of Officials by riders and/or members of their entourage.

It is essential that Officials report any such incidents to the FEI Legal Department using the FEI Incident Report Form. We would encourage you to cc the IEOC (mail@ieoc.info) if you find yourself in the position of submitting an incident report. It is important to remember the term "abuse" is generally understood to encompass psychological abuse as well as physical abuse.
